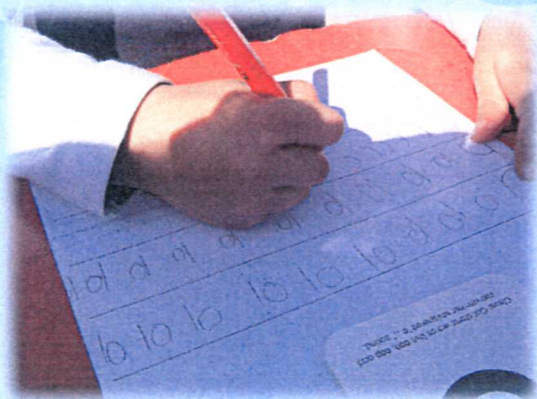


LETTERLAND

Since June the children have been exploring a phonics programme called Letterland. During our group times and throughout the day we have been exploring letterland characters and songs to help children recognise letters and sounds.

Today Tayler sat down with me and we looked at the letterland characters and letters we have learnt so far. Tayler was able to recall all of the letter sounds a, b, c, t and s. He was also confident in telling me the different letterland characters. Tayler then created his own letters.

Throughout his writing Tayler used his right hand. He held his pencil in a 3 finger hold. Tayler is beginning to form his letters and is confident in his writing.

What learning is happening here?

Tayler is learning skills in reading, writing and spelling through the letterland programme. He is developing his pencil grip and showing a great interest in his writing as he has already shown through his story book writing .
