

JUNIOR JUNCTION -BABIES

Here is a list of information you may need to know to make the transition smooth for you and your family:

- When you arrive there will be a special locker for you to keep your child's bag and belongings
- There will also be a labelled basket in the children's nappy change room to keep spare clothes, nappies and cream (if needed)
- Nappies - at least 4 per day
- You will need to bring at least 3 changes of spare clothes because we have lots of water, messy and art activities and we don't want your child to be cold or uncomfortable
- Various seasons require different garments such as in Summer children need to have light clothes and a sun hat, in Winter gumboots and Jackets are essential
- our child will have their own Sippy cup or you are welcome to bring in your own cup for them to have.
- If Your child sleeps with a comforter this will need to be brought in (blanket, toy or dummy)
- Formula and bottles — you may leave one or two bottles at the centre which we will sterilise after each use or you can take them home each day
- Please write down your child's routine and bring this in on your first visit.

On your visits before starting one of the teachers in the room will be appointed as your child's primary caregiver; this means that they will be responsible for settling your child, bonding with them and building on the child's confidence within the centre.
